Council officer elections were held on June 7<sup>th</sup> for the upcoming Fraternal Year. The following officers were elected:

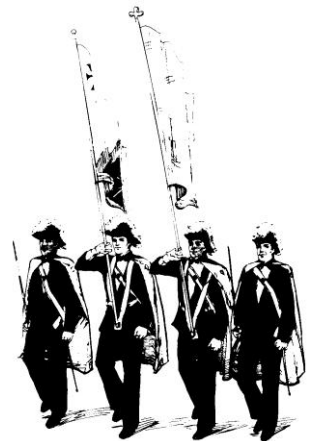

## **COUNCIL RESOLUTION REGARDING HILTON HOTELS**

During the council meeting on June 7<sup>th</sup>, Catholic Action Committee member Bob Struble reported Hilton Hotels supports both Planned Parenthood and Gay organizations. This was previously unknown to council 1379 and the state council. To assure KC members and councils are aware of this, the following resolution was passed and will be sent to the state council for action:

*Whereas*, the Hilton Hotel chain is a major contributor to Planned Parenthood,  
*Whereas*, the Hilton Hotel chain is a LGBT (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender) corporate partner  
*Resolved*, we urge the state KC council to avoid doing business that involves the transfer of funds to Hilton hotels.

## **CAMPAIGN FOR PEOPLE WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES AKA "TOOTSIE ROLL DRIVE"**

The council has approved a measure to begin participating in one of the Order's fundraising efforts for the disabled, commonly known as the "Tootsie Roll Drive".
